Dear Parents,

I hope you all had a good half term holiday.

Please can I ask that you ensure that all the children keep off the grass before school to avoid mud being trailed into school and also to protect the bulbs. Thank you.

#### Parents' afternoon/evening

I hope you can attend the parents' afternoon or evening on Thursday 5<sup>th</sup> March. To make an appointment, please complete the slip below and return it to your child's class teacher. The requests are dealt with on a 'first come first served basis.' If you are unable to attend please contact your child's class teacher to arrange an alternative date.

## **Medical appointments**

The Education Welfare Officer, who monitors children's attendance in school has noticed that an increasing number of children are having to access medical appointments during the school day. Wherever possible appointments should be kept to a minimum and made out of school hours. If there is no alternative then please can you ensure that you show the office staff the appointment cards/letters to the office so that this absence can be authorised. Thank you for your cooperation.

#### **Uniform**

The Uniform company will be in school on Thursday 12<sup>th</sup> March from 3.00 pm. If you are unable to attend and wish to place an order please collect an order form from the office. Orders and payment must be in school by the Thursday morning.

We will be holding a 'New to you' uniform sale before and after school during the week commencing Monday 16<sup>th</sup> March in the entrance hall.

## World book day - Friday 6<sup>th</sup> March

On World Book Day the children are allowed to come to school dressed up as a character from a book (preferably NOT super heroes). We will be doing some work specifically on stories throughout the day.

## 48 hour rule

Could I please remind you that, if your child has been sick and/or has diarrhoea, they **must** be off school for a full 48 hours from the last episode. If you leave a message on the answerphone regarding absence, could you please tell us what is wrong with your child. Thank you for your co-operation.

## **Parking**

Parking around school is a huge issue and can put children's lives at risk and inconvenience our neighbours! Remember the Tap pub, at the top of Dimple Well Lane, and the Cricket Club are happy for you to park your car there and walk the rest of the way. Please think carefully before you park, and please do not park in front of the back school gate at lunchtime or home time as members of staff often have meetings and courses to attend.

#### PTA Rag Bin

Just a quick reminder - the Rag Bin is available, just inside the Healey Road school gate, for unwanted clothes, bedding and shoes. The rags generate a steady income for the PTA so please mention to family members too. Thanks you.

## Sports Relief Day – Friday 13<sup>th</sup> March

On Friday 15th March the children may come to school dressed in sports clothes in exchange for a £1.00 donation to the appeal.

#### **Severe weather**

Should we have severe weather conditions, necessitating **closure of the school** we will send a message via Parent Hub, include a message on the **school website** <a href="http://dimplewell.wakefield.sch.uk">http://dimplewell.wakefield.sch.uk</a> and a list of school closures is also on the **Wakefield MDC website**: <a href="www.wakefield.gov.uk">www.wakefield.gov.uk</a> so please check all of these first.

It would be helpful if telephone calls to the school are kept to a minimum as staff may be delayed getting to school. If the phone is not answered it does not necessarily mean we will be closed. Closure is rare and the decision not to open will only be taken if insufficient staff can reach school, without putting themselves at risk.

If the weather is bad during the school day, parents should use their discretion about coming to collect their children early. If conditions on local roads seem to be deteriorating we may start to telephone parents and ask them to collect their children.

If you are unable to collect your child at 3.10pm because of the weather, they will be cared for until someone picks them up. However, if possible, **please phone** to let us know you are delayed so that we can reassure your child that you are safe. As ever, our main concern will always be the safety of the children, parents and staff.

#### **Punctuality**

Can I remind you that school officially starts at 8.55am. That means all the children should be ready to line up and enter school as the bell rings. A child arriving even 2 or 3 minutes late disrupts their learning and the learning of others, as learning begins as soon as the children enter the classroom.

Please do all you can to be at school on time, the Education Welfare Officer carries out regular punctuality checks.

#### **Holiday dates**

Attached is the holiday list for this year and next year. Please note that there is a zero tolerance to family holidays during term time and all will be classified as unauthorised. Year 1 take a statutory Phonic test in June and Year 2 complete their SAT tests in May. It is IMPERATIVE that your child attends school at those times. Thank you for your support and co-operation.


